### Admission Requirements:

1. A graduate of an approved School of Nursing
2. A registered nurse in good standing the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba
3. Recent (within the past two years) nursing experience in an acute care area; minimum of one year's experience as a Registered Nurse
4. Current BCLS certification (Must be Current within one year)
5. Must be an employee of Prairie Mountain Regional Health Authority or eligible to be employed.

### Application Form must be accompanied by:

1. Photocopy of current Active CRNM registration
2. Copy of Current CPR certification
3. A letter stating reasons for application to the Advanced Studies in Critical Care Nursing program. The letter should contain short and long term goals for their nursing career.
4. Resume of education and experience, including continuing education activities for past 2 years

### NOTE:

- **Applicant is responsible to obtain required reference from current employer / manager**
- **This reference is mailed in directly to the Care Team Manager of Critical Care (at the above address) from the employer and must be received by the close date specified.**
- **If you are accepted you will be expected to have copies of your High School and Nursing school transcripts sent to Mount Royal University directly from your institution of learning**
- **You may be required to provide other Documents as required by Mount Royal University at your own expense.**

### Selection Process:

1. All the above information must be received before application will be considered
2. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the admission requirements are fulfilled.
3. Applications from BRHC must receive approval for an educational LOA prior to final acceptance for full time study students
4. First preference will be given to nurses employed in the Critical Care areas within the BRHC then other nurses in acute care areas within the BRHC.
5. The Admission Committee will use their professional judgement in making selections
6. The decisions of the Admission Committee are final.
