Join our Community Volunteer Income Tax Program

The **Community Volunteer Income Tax Program** (CVITP) is a free service to help low-income individuals with simple tax situations complete and file their income tax and benefit return. Completing an income tax return can improve income by providing access to federal, provincial and local benefits and programs.

Volunteers must meet the following criteria to be eligible to volunteer with the program:

- Have basic tax knowledge
- Experience completing simple tax returns
- Familiar with and comfortable using computerized software (UFile)
- Can commit a few hours per week in March & April completing tax returns
- In good standing with CRA for personal taxes
- Must be 18 years of age
- Must be a Canadian resident with a valid SIN
- Access to secure computer and the internet
- Willing to complete a criminal record check (new volunteers)
