First-dose eligibility: Age 6 months & up

Second-dose eligibility: Age 6 months & up – 8 weeks after 1st dose

Bivalent COVID booster eligibility: Age 5 & up

Recommended to wait 6 months from last dose or COVID infection. However individuals at increased risk can get the bivalent 3 months after last dose or COVID infection. The bivalent vaccine has been developed to provide protection against two strains of COVID-19: the original strain of the virus and the omicron variant.

Individuals must complete their primary vaccine series (usually two doses) before receiving the bivalent vaccine. The bivalent vaccine can be given at the same time as other immunizations.
